the Medical Assistance program.

Medical Assistance provides a critical lifeline for many Wisconsinites. More than one in five Wisconsin citizens access health care through various MA programs. Hard times forces even more people to turn to the state for health care.

Choices made as part of the 2011-13 state budget put many at risk of losing their health care. Included in the state budget was language requiring DHS to request a waiver from the federal government that will allow the department to implement more restrictive eligibility standards, methodologies, and procedures.

The budget language also imposed an artificial deadline by which the federal government must act on the waivers of December 31, 2011.

As the deadline loomed, officials at CMS made several requests for preliminary information on the proposed waivers. Finally on November 10th the state submitted the waiver proposal.

While the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services granted preliminary approval of parts of the waiver, CMS Director Cindy Mann expressed concern about the ability to meet the December deadline.

Director Mann indicated CMS would need additional time to work with state officials on the proposals. They need more time to analyze how the proposals align or differ with the law and consider the impact on people now covered by MA programs.

LRB 3630 changes the deadline for federal government approval of wavier request to March 1, 2012. This bill would give the administration the necessary time to work with CMS to more carefully craft a proposal that would identify efficiencies in the state's MA program and consider options that will not leave thousands of

individuals, children and their families without access to health care.

SECTION 1. 49.45 (2m) (e) 2. of the statutes, as affected by 2011 Wisconsin Act 32, section 1423k, is amended to read:

49.45 (2m) (e) 2. The department shall request a waiver from the secretary of the federal department of health and human services to permit the department to have in effect eligibility standards, methodologies, and procedures under the state Medical Assistance plan or waivers of federal laws related to medical assistance that are more restrictive than those in place on March 23, 2010. If the waiver request does not receive federal approval before December 31, 2011 March 1, 2012, the department shall reduce income levels on July 1, 2012, for the purposes of determining eligibility to 133 percent of the federal poverty line for adults who are not pregnant and not disabled, to the extent permitted under 42 USC 1396a (gg), if the department follows the procedures under 42 USC 1396a (gg) (3).
