Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current federal law, law enforcement officers ^{a he or she is} with certain exceptions, ^{him or her} may carry a concealed weapon if ^{move} they are also carrying an identification issued by the law enforcement agency that employs them; this federal provision explicitly preempts any state prohibition. Under current state law, any person may apply for a license to carry a concealed weapon. When the person submits an application, the Department of Justice (DOJ) must run a background check on the applicant to see if he or she is prohibited from possessing a firearm. The person must also submit a fee to cover the costs of the application and the background check and must submit proof of training. Under this bill, DOJ must provide a license to carry a concealed weapon to all law enforcement officers without the fee, background check, or training required by applicants who are not law enforcement officers.
