

We would like to get an amendment drafted for AB 502.

- ✓ Remove sections 9 and 10 relating to a land owner being able to hunt wolves on their property without a permit or license
- ✓
 - Remove sections 19 and 20 relating to hunting from a roadway
 - Remove lines 12-15 on page six relating to closing a wolf zone to the hunting of coyotes during a gun deer season
- ✓ Extend the time the DNR has to submit a permanent rule to Leg Council from 4 months to 8 (page 11, line 14)
- ✓ Create a provision allowing for the purchase of a duplicate license for half the cost of the original
 - Clarify that if the wolf is re-listed as an endangered species any depredation costs come from the endangered species fund and if it is delisted, the depredation costs would come from the license and permit fees. See suggested language change from the DNR:
 - S 71.10(5)(am) is amended to read: *Gray wolf as endangered or threatened species*. For purposes of the part of the endangered resources program that provides for wildlife damage control and the payments of claims for damage associated with endangered or threatened species, the gray wolf shall be considered an endangered or threatened species ~~regardless of whether it is listed as endangered or threatened if the wolf is not on the U.S. list of endangered and threatened species, as it applies to this state, and is not on the list of endangered and threatened Wisconsin species that is established under s. 29.604 (3), at which time s. 29.888 would be in effect.~~

1. In s. 29.185 (1b), the “and” should not be changed to “or” because the defined term is being used throughout the bill to describe the wolf when it is **not** listed. I had included the definition “listed as endangered” in an attempt to make some of the provisions less wordy. However, I think the definition causes some confusion and is difficult to logically follow because it describes two concepts: being on the federal list and being on the state list. I therefore have redrafted this to define these two concepts separately. I think this improves the readability of the draft and makes it clear that the wolves must not appear on both lists in order for hunting to be allowed and for the depredation program to be in effect.

2. Regarding the opening or closing of hunting and trapping seasons for wolves and hunting seasons for coyotes, DNR already has the authority to do this by rule. See s. 29.014 (1) and the definition of “rule” under s. 227.01 (13). Therefore, such language is necessary only to exempt DNR from the rule making procedures for opening and closing these seasons. I moved the language dealing with rule making to s. 29.185 (5) ~~✱~~(e) so that it does cover both s. 29.185 (5) (c) and (d). 10 closure is no longer necessary to effectively manage the state’s wolf population.

11 (e) Notwithstanding ss. 29.014 and 227.10 (1), the opening and closing of wolf
