3           Whereas, the Wisconsin Badgers completed a dominant regular season,  
4       winning the Big Ten Title, finishing 11 and 1, and earning a bid to the Rose Bowl on  
5       January 1, 2011; and

6           Whereas, the annual Rose Bowl is the oldest of all college bowl games, and its  
7       history and prestige have earned it the title “The Granddaddy of Them All”; and

8           Whereas, the Rose Bowl was first played in 1902 and since 1945 has been the  
9       highest attended college football bowl game; and

10          Whereas, University of Wisconsin–Madison Chancellor Bidy Martin has  
11       exhibited strong leadership for the University of Wisconsin and an unyielding  
12       commitment to academic excellence for its student–athletes; and

13          Whereas, Athletic Director Barry Alvarez, a three–time Rose Bowl winning  
14       coach, helped lead the Badgers back to Pasadena, California; and
