WHEREAS, Women comprise fifty-two percent (52 %) of the United States population but bear the sole responsibility for childbearing; and

WHEREAS, Women who plan their pregnancies are more likely to seek prenatal care, improving their own health and the health of their children; and

WHEREAS, Supporters of women's reproductive rights include the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, Planned Parenthood, National Organization for Women, NARAL Pro-Choice, Center for Reproductive Rights and the National Family Planning and Reproductive Health Assn just to mention a very few
