1 **Relating to:** honoring the life and achievements of Donald J. Schneider.

2 Whereas, Donald "Don" Schneider, passed away on Friday, January 13, 2012,
3 at the age of 76 in Green Bay, Wisconsin; and

4 Whereas, Don Schneider was born in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, on October 19,
5 1935, and attended Catholic Central High School and graduated from St. Norbert
6 College with a degree in business, ^{and} earned his master's degree from the University
7 of Pennsylvania's Wharton School of Business; and

8 Whereas, Don Schneider married his wife of 54 years, Patricia "Pat" O'Brien at
9 St. Patrick's Church in Green Bay in 1957; and

10 Whereas, Don Schneider served a 13-month tour of duty in Korea with the U.S.
11 Army; and

12 Whereas, Don Schneider joined his father's trucking company, Schneider
13 Transport & Storage and also taught finance at St. Norbert College; and

1 Whereas, in 1976 he assumed leadership of his father's company and served as
2 president and CEO until 2002 and Chairman Emeritus until his death; and

3 Whereas, even as CEO, ^{he} was seen wearing blue jeans and a denim shirt and was
4 known to associates as simply "Don"; and

5 Whereas, Don Schneider grew the company by being a leader in innovation and
6 hard work that provided jobs to thousands of hard-working employees, and under his
7 leadership the fast growing company began calling itself "Big Orange"; and

8 Whereas, in 1982 ^{he} created the Schneider National Foundation, which has
9 donated millions of dollars and thousands of volunteer hours to charities in need,
10 ^{and he served} while serving as chair of the Capital Campaign for Notre Dame Academy, ^{chair} the annual
11 campaign for United Way of Brown County, ^{and} chairman of the Catholic High School
12 Foundation, while the Schneider Family provided the lead gift for the St. Norbert
13 Athletic Stadium; and

14 Whereas, Don Schneider shared his time and talents as chairman of the
15 Business Advisory Committee for Northwestern University's Transportation Center,
16 a member of the Advisory Board for the Kellogg School of Management, a director
17 on the Federal Reserve Board in Chicago, a member of the Boards of Directors at Fort
18 Howard Paper Company and Franklin Electric, a member of the Board and
19 Executive Committee of the Green Bay Packers, and a member of the Board of
20 Trustees of St. Norbert College; and

21 Whereas, Don Schneider touched the lives of countless people during his
22 lifetime, helping to transform and lead a small trucking company into a world leader;
23 and

24 Whereas, Don Schneider will be deeply missed by his wife, Pat, his five children,
25 Mary, Therese, Thomas, Kathleen, and Paul, 13 grandchildren, two

1 great-grandchildren, and members of the Schneider National family around the
2 world, and ^{by} all who were fortunate enough to meet him; now, therefore, be it

3 **Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That** the members of the
4 Wisconsin legislature honor Don Schneider for his service, vision, and leadership in
5 transforming the trucking industry, ^{his} charitable works, and ^{his} impact on the lives of so
6 many, express their sorrow over his passing, and extend their condolences to his
7 family, friends, and colleagues; and be it further

8 **Be it further** ^R resolved, **That** the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of
9 this joint resolution to Don Schneider's wife, ^{Pat} and his children, Mary DePrey,
10 Therese Koller, Thomas Schneider, Kathleen Zimmermann, and Paul Schneider. ✓
