Today, please

1 **Relating to:** protecting First Amendment rights.

2 Whereas, both the Wisconsin and ^{Constitute the U.S.} United States Constitution ^S protect each
3 individual's right to exercise freedom of speech and expression; and

4 Whereas, our communities and state benefit when our government is open and
5 transparent, and encourages and facilitates encouraging and facilitating citizen participation in the legislative
6 process; and ^{SILT}

7 Whereas, the Wisconsin ^{SILT} State Capitol is the people's house, and should be open
8 to the people; and

9 Whereas, individuals have been removed from the assembly gallery who have

10 been peacefully assembled and nondisruptive ^{and} (because of ~~signs~~ ^{and} ~~other~~ ^{slogans} and
11 ^{for affixing} communications ~~affixed~~ ^{affixed} to their clothing or ^{carrying} ~~carrying~~ small, unobtrusive signs; and ^{SILT}

12 Whereas, an individual's right to participate and observe ^{the} ~~our~~ legislative process

13 is not dependent on any message affixed to ^{his or her} ~~their~~ attire, which constitute the peaceful
14 expression of ^{that individual's} ~~their~~ views; and ^S

1 Whereas, an individual's right to peacefully participate in the legislative
 2 process should not be conditioned on surrendering ^{his or her} ~~their~~ protected first amendment
 3 rights; and

4 Whereas, the role of the state assembly should not be to prohibit ~~mere~~ peaceful
 5 expression or to proscribe ideas of those assembled in the assembly gallery, but ^{to} ~~to~~ should
 6 encourage citizen participation in our government; now, therefore, be it

7 **Resolved by the assembly, That** ^{that} ~~that~~ the assembly recognizes and encourages
 8 each individual's participation in the legislative process, ^{each individual's} ~~their~~ right to observe the
 9 legislative process, and ^{each individual's (peaceful) expression of his or her views} ~~the peaceful expression of their views in doing so~~ in the
 10 assembly gallery.
