

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 1. Page 10, line 15: substitute "\$350,000,000" for "\$500,000,000".
- 3 2. Page 10, line 16: substitute "2027" for "2026".
- 4 3. Page 10, line 16: after that line insert:
- 5 "(e) After the department of revenue deposits a total of \$350,000,000 into the
- 6 fund under par. (d), and subject to the requirements of this paragraph, the
- 7 department shall continue depositing moneys into the fund under par. (b), not to
- 8 exceed an additional total amount of \$150,000,000 in deposits. Before the
- 9 department continues those deposits, the department shall notify the joint
- 10 committee on finance in writing that the department intends to do so. If, within 14
- 11 working days after the date of that notice, the cochairpersons of the committee do not
- 12 notify the department that the committee has scheduled a meeting to review the
- 13 continuation of deposits into the fund, the department shall continue those deposits.

1 If, within 14 working days after the date of that notice, the cochairpersons of the
2 committee notify the department that the committee has scheduled a meeting to
3 review the department's continuation of deposits into the fund, the department may
4 continue those deposits only upon approval of the committee.".

5 and investments the board makes in that fiscal year."

Disregard this last message. I confused myself. Mike and I worked it out and we will have the following provisions in the amendment:

--Place a cap on non-revenue producing grants by the board at 10% of amount invested in any year. (SA3 to SSSB21, Lassa) *(included in SA1 to SA1)* ✓

--Cap the funds deposited into the fund in the first year at \$15M, then cap at \$50M annually for each year *after* the first year. (LRB 1710/1, Wanggaard/Taylor) ✓

--Cap the initial fund maximum at \$350M. Require JFC authorization to get remaining \$150M into the fund. (LRB 1863/1, Wanggaard/Taylor) ✓

-- Require that the board report the individualized rate of return on each investment in the annual report; require that the Board report on the number of jobs created; and Place a cap on non-revenue producing grants by the board at 10% of amount invested in any year (*same as SA3 to SSSB21, Lassa*). (SA1 to SA1 to SSSB21 Wanggaard/Darling/Taylor) ✓
