Joe,

Pursuant to my voicemail, please draft an amendment to ASA 1 to AB 220 (workplace wellness tax credits) to require a claimant to first apply for and exhaust federal workplace wellness grant opportunities provided under Sec. 10408 of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) before being eligible to apply for the tax credits provided under AB 220.

The Assembly Health Committee will be holding an executive session on AB 220 on Wednesday, Oct. 19, at 10:00 a.m. The Chair requires all amendments to be introduced at least 24 hours before the executive session.

We'd like to give committee members sufficient time to review our amendment, and possibly co-sponsor it, before the exec. Any chance you might be able to complete this amendment by tomorrow afternoon or first thing Monday morning?
