Hi Aaron,

We received a couple new concerns from DOT about SB 261 that we would like drafted up in an amendment. They are fairly small changes, so we would be fine with just a simple amendment. However, if you think the accumulation of changes between SA 1 and the new amendment would be best drafted as a substitute amendment, we would be open to that as well.

DOT's new concerns were as follows:

1. 2011 Act 59 allows the 3rd vehicle in a combination to carry no load. They would like SB 261 to reflect that as well for consistency.
2. Could you add the word "equestrian" in front of the word "supplies" on Page 2 Line 14? They were concerned that it wasn't clear that the reference to supplies was only for equestrian purposes.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 6.

3 2. Page 2, line 13: delete "and" and substitute "including any combination
4 camping-horse trailer,".

5 3. Page 2, line 14: ~~delete~~ "supplies" ~~insert~~ ^{and substitute} for recreational purposes, and the
6 2nd or 3rd vehicle in the 3-vehicle combination is equipped with brakes if the total
7 weight, including any load, of all towed vehicles exceeds 3,000 pounds. No 3-vehicle
8 combination may operate under this paragraph if highway or weather conditions
9 include heavy snow, freezing rain, icy roads, high winds, limited visibility, or upon
10 a highway that is closed or partially closed by the department due to highway
11 conditions".
