

Whereas, stroke is a leading cause of serious long-term disability and the third leading cause of death in the United States, killing over 136,000 people nationwide and over 2,400 ^{residents} ~~citizens~~ of Wisconsin each year; and

Whereas, warning signs of stroke include sudden numbness or weakness of the face, arm, or leg, especially on one side of the body; sudden confusion ^{of} ~~trouble~~ and speaking or understanding; sudden trouble seeing in one or both eyes; sudden trouble walking, dizziness, ^{or} loss of balance or coordination; and sudden severe headache with no known cause; and

Whereas, Americans are more aware of the risk factors and warning signs for stroke than in the past, but two in five adults still cannot identify any symptoms; and
