**Whereas**, the Wisconsin National Guard 950<sup>th</sup> Engineer Company was deployed in April of 2010 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation New Dawn; and

**Whereas**, the 950<sup>th</sup> Engineer Company, based in Superior, was one of eight engineering companies that made up the 724<sup>th</sup> Engineer Battalion; and

**Whereas**, the 950<sup>th</sup> Engineer Company was a part of the only remaining engineering battalion in Iraq before recently returning home; and

**Whereas**, the 950<sup>th</sup> Engineer Company's 101 soldiers returned home on Friday, February 18 to a crowd of nearly 1,000 friends and family after a 10-month deployment in Iraq; and

**Whereas**, the 950<sup>th</sup> Engineer Company, operating as Task Force Badger, has been awarded 135 combat action badges, six Purple Hearts and four combat medic badges; and

**Whereas**, the 950<sup>th</sup> Engineer Company's principal mission, as part of the Task Force Badger, was to provide freedom of movement throughout Iraq. The task force cleared an area of 200,000 kilometers, searching and removing roadside bombs, leading the battalion to adopt the motto, "We hunt what others fear;" and

**Whereas**, the 950<sup>th</sup> Engineer Company also removed five major military bridges, completed construction work for Iraqi forces, trained Iraqi forces in bridging techniques and assisted the State Department in the construction of Contingency Operation Station Erbil in northern Iraq; and

**Whereas**, the state of Wisconsin is forever grateful to the soldiers of the Wisconsin National Guard 950<sup>th</sup> Engineer Company for their service to their country; now, therefore, be it
