TO ASSEMBLY BILL 5

January 25, 2011 - Offered by Representatives STEINBRINK, STASKUNAS, JORGENSEN and HULSEY.

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after "legislation" insert "and legislation decreasing or
- 3 modifying general school aids, general transportation aids, and shared revenue
- 4 payments, and legislation that will likely increase local property taxes".
- 5 **2.** Page 1, line 4: after "rates" insert "**or local property taxes, or**
- 6 **decreasing or modifying general school aids, general transportation aids,**
- 7 **or shared revenue payments"**.
- 8 **3.** Page 1, line 6: after "franchise tax" insert "or that decreases general school
- 9 aids, general transportation aids, or shared revenue payments from the amount
- 10 appropriated in the prior fiscal year or that modifies the distribution of general
- 11 school aids, general transportation aids, or shared revenue payments or that will
- 12 likely increase local property taxes".
