

Bob, here's what I did. If you don't like it, I'll redraft.

I redrafted LRB-0851 without combining it with LRB-1191. I redrafted LRB-1191 simply to make it easier later on to reconcile the two drafts. I'll include in the UW authority draft the authorization for the authority to establish charter schools.

Getting back to LRB-0851, I proceeded as if all the intended collective bargaining changes will not occur. (I have to do that; the changes are in a different bill and may not become law.) So take a look at how I amended 20.923 (6) (m), 111.81 (7) (f), 111.815 (1), 111.825 (2) (f), 111.92 (1) (c), 118.40 (7) (am) 2., 230.08 (2) (dm), and 230.35 (1s). Let me know if you want to change any of it. If you want the current provisions to still apply only to the UW-Parkside charter school even though all other UW institutions are authorized to establish charter schools... I think that would be odd, but whatever...I'll draft it that way.

I think it might make sense to have the 20.923(6)(m) provision apply to instructional staff employed by UW System who provide services to any of the charter schools established by a UW System campus.

I think 111.81(7)(f), which relates to definition of employee should be amended to refer to any instructional staff to employed by the Regents to serve any charter school, unless by putting them in the definition of employee in this section means they are subject to collective bargaining. If that's true, leave the language alone.

The other references in Chapter 111, I would let stand. I'll assume that whatever we're doing on collective bargaining will address the issue.

Regarding 230.08(2) (dm) and (wc), 230.08(2)(wc) is not in the statutes as far as I can tell. I would expand (dm) to include any system instructional staff serving a charter school. I would let the 230.35(1s) language stand.

Hi Bob,

If you want to eliminate 118.40 (2r) (cm), what do you want to do with 20.923 (6) (m), 111.81 (7) (f), 111.815 (1), 111.825 (2) (f), 111.92 (1)(c), 230.08 (2) (dm) and (wc), and 230.35 (1s)? (Just a reminder: as I understand it, collective bargaining is being dealt with in the budget adjustment bill, and we can't assume that bill is law yet.)

If we delete 118.40 (2r) (b) 1. c., do you want to remove any reference to UW-Parkside in 118.40 (7) (am) 2.? Or would you rather that sentence refer to all UW charter schools?

I think I'll combine these two drafts by incorporating LRB-1191 into LRB-0851, OK?

Also, instead of putting your item 6 in this draft, I'd rather incorporate it into the University of Wisconsin draft. Is that okay, or do you not want the UW-Madison folks to see it?

And finally, do you want to require the chancellor of the University of Wisconsin to obtain the approval of the board of trustees in order to establish a charter school? You know, as is currently required of System institutions? Actually, now that I think about this, it may make sense to put this item in this draft instead of the UW draft, because we're amending that provision in this draft anyway. See 118.40 (2r) (b) 2. Well, I'll wait to hear from you.

I think we (I'm taking completely undeserved credit for your work) could combine draft 0851 and 1191 (allowing a business organization to charter) into a single draft, since both relate to chartering entities. Furthermore, what is currently draft 0851 should be amended to:

1. repeal s. 118.40(2r)(b)3. The statewide expansion should treat UW Parkside no differently than other UW campuses.
2. delete the references to UW Milwaukee and UW-Parkside under s. 118.40(2r)(bm). Since there are no geographic restrictions on other UW campuses regarding where they establish charter schools, there should be no restrictions on either of these campuses.
3. repeal s. 118(2r)(cm). Since there are no restrictions on the number of charter schools that any other campus can establish, there should be no restrictions on Parkside.
4. repeal s. 118.40(2r)(e)2. The Racine school district should not be given preferential funding treatment under a statewide program.
5. repeal s. 118.40(2r)(f). UW-Parkside should not have additional reporting requirements under the statewide program.
6. amend s. 118(2r)(b)1 to add the new independent University of Wisconsin Board of Trustees (being created in this bill) as a chartering entity.

Basically, the goal of these amendments is to create a true statewide independent charter school program, with UW campuses as the chartering entity and with UW-Milwaukee and UW-Parkside being treated like any other campus. Schools must still meet other state requirements (like offering state tests) and can only accept students who reside in the district where they are located.
