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

CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM

JUVENILE CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM

Current law requires the Office of Justice Assistance in DOA (OJA) to allocate \$500,000 in each fiscal year to enter into a contract with an organization to provide services in Milwaukee County, \$150,000 in each fiscal year to enter into a contract with an organization to provide services in Racine County, \$150,000 in each fiscal year to enter into a contract with an organization to provide services in Kenosha County, \$150,000 in each fiscal year to enter into a contract with an organization located in ward two in the city of Racine to provide services in Racine County, \$150,000 in each fiscal year to enter into a contract with an organization to provide services in Brown County, and \$100,000 in each fiscal year to enter into a contract with a discretionary organization, for the diversion of youths from gang activities into productive activities (Youth Diversion Program). Current law also requires OJA to distribute not more than \$300,000 to the organization providing services in Milwaukee County for alcohol and other drug abuse (AODA) education and treatment services for participants in that organization's program.

This bill requires OJA to reduce the allocations for the Youth Diversion Program by \$50,200 for the organization providing services in Milwaukee County, \$25,650 for each of the organizations providing services in Racine County, Kenosha County, and Brown County, and \$18,100 for the discretionary organization in each
