Under s. 118.19(1) and 121.02(1)(a)2, charter school teachers are required to be licensed. Amend this section to create an exception for teachers in charter schools created under s. 118.40(2r). Teachers in 2r charter schools would be required to have at least a bachelor's degree.

The intent is to require 2r charter school teachers to meet the same minimum teacher qualification standard as choice schools under s. 119.23(2)(a)6. a.
