PUBLIC ASSISTANCE

Under current law, DHS administers the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, formerly known as the food stamp program and currently known in Wisconsin as FoodShare, under which eligible low-income individuals and families receive cash assistance to purchase food. This bill transfers the administration of FoodShare to DCF on January 1, 2013. ✓

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Analysis

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

14 program and another subunit of the department. Total administrative funding
15 authorized for the program under s. 49.665 may not exceed 10% of the amounts
