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

Currently, DOA must contract with one or more child care providers to supplement the cost of providing suitable space for child care services provided to the children of employees of state agencies whose work stations are located in the central Madison area. DOA must assess the costs of providing child care services to state agencies on an equitable basis as determined by DOA and the agencies may draw upon program supplement appropriations to finance any unbudgeted costs for these assessments. This bill deletes the requirement for DOA to enter into these contracts and instead grants permission for DOA to do so.
