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

Current law requires the attorney general to establish a bureau in *the*
~~Department of Justice (DOJ)~~ for DOJ's gaming law enforcement responsibilities.
This bill eliminates the requirement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 SECTION 1. 20.455 (2) (g) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 20.455 (2) (g) *Gaming law enforcement; racing revenues.* From all moneys
6 received under ss. 562.02 (2) (f), 562.04 (1) (b) 4. and (2) (d), 562.05 (2), 562.065 (3)
7 (cm) and (d), (3m) (c) 2., and (4), 562.09 (2) (e), and 562.124 (2), the amounts in the
8 schedule for the performance of the department's gaming law enforcement
9 responsibilities ~~as specified in s. 165.70 (3m) under chs. 562 to 569 and 945.~~

1 Notwithstanding s. 20.001 (3) (a), the unencumbered balance of this appropriation
2 account at the end of each fiscal year shall be transferred to the lottery fund.

3 **SECTION 2.** 20.455 (2) (r) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 20.455 (2) (r) *Gaming law enforcement; lottery revenues.* From the lottery fund,
5 the amounts in the schedule for the performance of the department's gaming law
6 enforcement responsibilities ~~as specified in s. 165.70 (3m)~~ under chs. 562 to 569 and
7 945.

8 **SECTION 3.** 165.70 (3m) of the statutes is repealed.
