

Rick:

We want to know if we can amend the bill to require WEDC to provide programs that are substantially similar to the economic development programs currently statutorily required of the Department of Commerce in Chapter 560. Can we do that in a blanket way? Also, that any amendment or elimination of those existing economic development policies, or the creation of new economic development policies, would have to be done by statute. The intent is that WEDC has to follow the economic development policy direction the Legislature has created for Commerce, and that the Legislature has to approve any new economic development policy proposed for WEDC. Let me know what your questions are!

**SENATE AMENDMENT ,
TO SENATE BILL 6**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 19, line 12: after “**of board.**” insert “**(1)**”.

3 **2.** Page 19, line 17: after that line insert:

4 “**(2)** No later than January 1, 2012, the board shall establish and implement
5 economic development programs that are substantially similar to the economic
6 development programs administered by the department of commerce. Once the
7 board has established and implemented these programs, the board may not alter or
8 eliminate the programs unless directed to do so by law.

9 **(3)** No later than January 1, 2012, the board shall identify all economic
10 development programs at the department of commerce that require a change in law
11 for the board to establish and implement and shall submit a report to the chief clerks

1 of the legislature, for distribution to the legislature under s. 13.172[✓] (2), containing
2 proposed legislation to allow the board to establish and implement the programs.”.
