TO SENATE BILL 6

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill[✓] as follows:

2 **1.** Page 18, line 24: delete “, and 11” and substitute “; 6”[✓].

3 **2.** Page 19, line 1: after “governor”[✓] insert “; 3 members appointed by the
4 speaker of the assembly, consisting of one majority and one minority party
5 representative to the assembly, appointed as are the members of standing
6 committees in the assembly, and one person employed in the private sector, to serve
7 at the speaker’s pleasure[✓]; and 3 members appointed by the senate majority leader,
8 consisting of one majority and one minority party senator, appointed as are members
9 of standing committees in the senate, and one person employed in the private sector,
10 to serve at the majority leader’s pleasure”[✓].
