## **2011 BILL**

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AN ACT ...; relating to: membership of the joint legislative council.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The Joint Legislative Council is comprised of 22 members consisting of the speaker of the assembly and the president of the senate, the speaker pro tempore of the assembly and the president pro tempore of the senate, the senate and assembly majority and minority leaders, the 2 cochairpersons of the joint committee on finance, the ranking minority member of the joint committee on finance from each house, and 5 senators and 5 representatives to the assembly appointed as are the members of standing committees in their respective house. This bill permits the speaker of the assembly or the president of the searce to decline to serve as member of the Joint Legislative Council and, instead, appoint a replacement member of his or her house to the joint legislative council.

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The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 13.81 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

13.81 (1) CREATION. There is created a joint legislative council of 22 members consisting of the speaker of the assembly and the president of the senate, the speaker pro tempore of the assembly and the president pro tempore of the senate, the senate

and assembly majority and minority leaders, the 2 cochairpersons of the joint committee on finance, the ranking minority member of the joint committee on finance from each house, and 5 senators and 5 representatives to the assembly appointed as are the members of standing committees in their respective houses. The speaker of the assembly and the president of the senate, or the designee of each from within the membership of that house on the council, shall serve as cochairpersons of the council. The speaker of the assembly or the president of the seante may decline to serve as member of the joint legislative council and, instead, appoint a replacement member of his or her house to the joint legislative council.
