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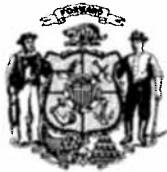

and BROOKS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute  
2 amendment 1, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “milk,” insert “financial assistance to local health  
4 departments for responding to outbreaks of illness associated with the consumption  
5 of unpasteurized milk.”

6 **2.** Page 1, line 3: delete “and”.

7 **3.** Page 1, line 4: after “rules” insert “, and making an appropriation”.

8 **4.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:

9 “**SECTION 1b.** 20.115 (1) (gb) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 20.115 (1) (gb) *Food regulation.* The amounts in the schedule for the regulation  
11 of food under chs. 93, 97 and 98. All moneys received under ss. 93.06 (1r) and (1w),  
12 93.09, 93.11, 93.12, 97.17, 97.175, 97.20, 97.21, 97.22, 97.24 (2) and (3) to (8), 97.27,

1 97.29, 97.30 (3) (a), (b) and (c), 97.41, 98.145 and 98.146 for the regulation of food  
2 shall be credited to this appropriation.

3 **SECTION 1c.** 20.115 (1) (t) of the statutes is created to read:

4 20.115 (1) (t) *Unpasteurized milk regulation.* From the unpasteurized milk  
5 public health fund, 25 percent of the moneys received under s. 97.24 (2g) (be) for  
6 administering s. 97.24 (2g).

7 **SECTION 1d.** 20.435 (1) (r) of the statutes is created to read:

8 20.435 (1) (r) *Unpasteurized milk public health local assistance.* From the  
9 unpasteurized milk public health fund, 75 percent of the moneys received under s.  
10 97.24 (2g) (be) for financial assistance to local health departments under s. 250.04  
11 (15).

12 **SECTION 1g.** 25.17 (1) (xLm) of the statutes is created to read:

13 25.17 (1) (xLm) Unpasteurized milk public health fund (s. 25.55).

14 **SECTION 1j.** 25.55 of the statutes is created to read:

15 **25.55 Unpasteurized milk public health fund.** There is established a  
16 separate nonlapsible trust fund designated as the unpasteurized milk public health  
17 fund consisting of all moneys received under s. 97.24 (2r) (be).”.

18 **5.** Page 2, line 1: delete “**SECTION 1**” and substitute “**SECTION 1s**”.

19 **6.** Page 3, line 24: after that line insert:

20 “(be) For each sale of unpasteurized milk for human consumption, collect a  
21 public health safety fee from the purchaser at the rate of \$1 per quart, and each  
22 month pay to the department the total amount of public health safety fees collected  
23 during the previous month.”.

Vicky Selkove:

Here is a preliminary draft to review while you make the decision about whether to impose a fee to fund the financial assistance. As this is drafted, DNR would provide the financial assistance from an existing environmental fund appropriation for administering water programs. The draft does not provide any additional funding.

As for the idea of a fee, the parallel to AA 4 to 2009 SB 434 would seem to be to require the municipal water systems that do not provide continuous disinfection to pay any fee. I heard the number of systems that do not provide continuous disinfection, but while I think it was a fairly small number, I do not remember what it was. In any event, the draft could require those systems to pay \$500, \$1,000, or some other amount per year to be used for this purpose.
