Hey Jeff,

I'm sorry to come back to you with several last minute amendment requests but this one is above my pay grade. I don't know how you can make this work, but our leadership team would like to see an amendment that appropriates an amount of money equal to what is being lost via the Voter ID bill to local road aids. I know that the voter id bill does not appropriate any money, but according to LFB estimates it is a loss of approximately \$7.4 to the state. Is there a way that you could insert an appropriation into the bill of \$7.4 million for local road aids? Again, this doesn't technically have to "work" per se, we just want to be able to make the argument on the floor.

Also, could you please draft another amendment that would allow any publicly issued id to satisfy the voter id requirements? We would like that amendment to be as broad as possible.
