SECTION <sup>116</sup> ~~213g~~ 343.16 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 343.16 (3) (a) The department shall examine every applicant for the renewal  
5 of an operator's license once every 8 years. The department may institute a method  
6 of selecting the date of renewal so that such examination shall be required for each  
7 applicant for renewal of a license to gain a uniform rate of examinations. The  
8 examination shall consist of a test of eyesight. The department shall make  
9 provisions for giving such examinations at examining stations in each county to all  
10 applicants for an operator's license. At least one examining station in each county  
11 shall be open for business on each Saturday and until at least 9 p.m. on at least one  
12 other day of each week. Examining stations in each county where any election is held

1 shall be open for business until at least 9 p.m. on each weekday during the week of  
 2 the election and the week immediately preceding the election and after the election  
 3 until the deadline described in s. 6.97 (3) (b), and the department shall, during this  
 4 period, provide priority service to applicants seeking identification for voting. The  
 5 person to be examined shall appear at the examining station nearest the person's  
 6 place of residence or at such time and place as the department designates in answer  
 7 to an applicant's request. In lieu of examination, the applicant may present or mail  
 8 to the department a report of examination of the applicant's eyesight by an  
 9 ophthalmologist, optometrist, or physician licensed to practice medicine. The report  
 10 shall be based on an examination made not more than 3 months prior to the date it  
 11 is submitted. The report shall be on a form furnished and in the form required by  
 12 the department. The department shall decide whether, in each case, the eyesight  
 13 reported is sufficient to meet the current eyesight standards.

 15 20 and 2011 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:

16 343.16 (3) (a) Except as provided in s. 343.165 (4) (d), the department shall  
 17 examine every applicant for the renewal of an operator's license once every 8 years.  
 18 The department may institute a method of selecting the date of renewal so that such  
 19 examination shall be required for each applicant for renewal of a license to gain a  
 20 uniform rate of examinations. The examination shall consist of a test of eyesight.

13 current eyesight standards."
