3 "SECTION 74m. 6.76 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 6.76 (1m) Any person who is entitled to vote in an election is entitled to be  
5 absent from work for not more than 3 successive hours during the period specified  
6 in s. 6.97 (3) (b) if the person casts a provisional ballot or the person's absentee ballot  
7 is considered to be provisional under s. 6.97 at the election because the person did  
8 not present proof of identification or enclose a copy of proof of identification when  
9 voting and the person needs time to obtain proof of identification and to provide the  
10 proof to the municipal clerk. The person shall provide notice to the affected employer

1 before his or her intended absence and the employer may designate the time for the  
2 absence.”.
