TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT ,
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 7

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 17, line 30: after that line insert:

3 "(g) If an individual is a student at a university, college, or technical college in
4 this state and is not able to present any of the documents specified in pars. (a) to (f),
5 an affidavit in the form prescribed by the board specifying the individual's name and
6 address, affirming the individual's identity and stating that this is the address of the
7 individual's residence."

8 2. Page 80, line 17: after that line insert:

9 "SECTION 143g. 7.51 (5) (a) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

10 7.51 (5) (a) 4. The inspectors shall immediately deliver all ballots, statements,
11 tally sheets, lists, and envelopes, and affidavits to the municipal clerk.

12 SECTION 143r. 7.51 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 7.51 (5) (b) The municipal clerk shall deliver all ballots, statements, tally
2 sheets, lists, and envelopes relating to a school district election to the school district
3 clerk by 4 p.m. on the day following each such election. The municipal clerk shall
4 deliver the ballots, statements, tally sheets, lists, and envelopes for his or her
5 municipality relating to any county, technical college district, state, or national
6 election to the county clerk no later than 4 p.m. on the day following each such
7 election or, in municipalities where absentee ballots are canvassed under s. 7.52, by
8 4 p.m. on the 2nd day following each such election, and no later than 4 p.m. on the
9 day after receiving any corrected returns under s. 6.221 (6) (b). The person delivering
10 the returns shall be paid out of the municipal treasury. Each clerk shall retain
11 ballots, statements, tally sheets, ~~or envelopes,~~ and affidavits received by the clerk
12 until destruction is authorized under s. 7.23 (1)."
