TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 7

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page ¹²12, line ²⁵25. after that line insert:

3 "(g) If an individual has a physical disability and is not able to present any of
4 the documents specified in pars. (a) to (f), an affidavit in the form prescribed by the
5 board specifying the individual's name and address, affirming the individual's
6 identity and stating that this is the address of the individual's residence."

7 2. Page ⁸⁰80, line ¹⁷17. after that line insert:

8 "SECTION ^{143g}143g. 7.51 (5) (a) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

9 7.51 (5) (a) 4. The inspectors shall immediately deliver all ballots, statements,
10 tally sheets, lists, and envelopes, and affidavits to the municipal clerk.

11 SECTION ^{106r}106r. 7.51 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 7.51 (5) (b) The municipal clerk shall deliver all ballots, statements, tally
2 sheets, lists, and envelopes relating to a school district election to the school district
3 clerk by 4 p.m. on the day following each such election. The municipal clerk shall
4 deliver the ballots, statements, tally sheets, lists, and envelopes for his or her
5 municipality relating to any county, technical college district, state, or national
6 election to the county clerk no later than 4 p.m. on the day following each such
7 election or, in municipalities where absentee ballots are canvassed under s. 7.52, by
8 4 p.m. on the 2nd day following each such election, and no later than 4 p.m. on the
9 day after receiving any corrected returns under s. 6.221 (6) (b). The person delivering
10 the returns shall be paid out of the municipal treasury. Each clerk shall retain
11 ballots, statements, tally sheets, ~~or envelopes,~~ and affidavits received by the clerk
12 until destruction is authorized under s. 7.23 (1).".
