TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 7

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page ⁸~~12~~, line 1: before that line insert:

3 "SECTION 1d. 5.02 (6e) of the statutes is created to read:

4 5.02 (6e) "Homeless person" means an individual who lacks a fixed, regular,
5 and adequate nighttime residence and who has a nighttime residence that is one of
6 the following:

7 (a) A supervised publicly or privately operated shelter designed to provide
8 temporary living accommodations.

9 (b) An institution that provides a temporary residence for individuals intended
10 to be institutionalized.

11 (c) A public or private place not designed for, or ordinarily used as, a regular
12 sleeping accommodation for human beings."
