**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 33,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 7**

May 11, 2011 – Offered by Representatives GRIGSBY, YOUNG and E. COGGS.

- 1           At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
- 2           **1.** Page 11, line 6: delete lines 6 to 15.
- 3           **2.** Page 11, line 19: delete “~~10 28~~” and substitute “10”.
- 4           **3.** Page 11, line 23: delete the material beginning with “~~10 his~~” and ending  
5 with “~~28~~” on line 24 and substitute “his or her residence later than 10”.
- 6           **4.** Page 12, line 1: delete lines 1 to 13.
- 7           **5.** Page 12, line 17: delete “~~10 28 consecutive~~” and substitute “10”.
- 8           **6.** Page 12, line 21: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
9 with page 13, line 22.
- 10          **7.** Page 16, line 15: delete “~~10 28 consecutive~~” and substitute “10”.
- 11          **8.** Page 17, line 21: delete lines 21 to 24.

- 1           **9.** Page 20, line 4: delete “10 28 consecutive” and substitute “10”.
- 2           **10.** Page 20, line 25: delete “10 28 consecutive” and substitute “10”.
- 3           **11.** Page 24, line 22: delete “10 28 consecutive” and substitute “10”.
- 4           **12.** Page 25, line 3: delete lines 3 to 15.
- 5           **13.** Page 32, line 14: delete lines 14 to 23 and substitute:
- 6           “**SECTION 87m.** 6.85 of the statutes is amended to read:
- 7           **6.85 Absent elector; ~~definition~~ electors.** **(1)** An absent elector is any
- 8 otherwise qualified elector who for any reason is unable or unwilling to appear at the
- 9 polling place in his or her ward or election district.
- 10           **(2)** Any otherwise qualified elector who changes residence within this state by
- 11 moving to a different ward or municipality later than 10 days prior to an election may
- 12 vote an absentee ballot in the ward or municipality where he or she was qualified to
- 13 vote before moving.
- 14           **(3)** An absent elector qualifying under this section may vote by absentee ballot
- 15 under ss. 6.86 to 6.89.”.
- 16           **14.** Page 40, line 2: delete “10 later than 28” and substitute “later than 10”.
- 17           **15.** Page 52, line 19: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
- 18 with page 53, line 10.
- 19           **16.** Page 60, line 9: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
- 20 with page 61, line 5.
