As you have probably heard, the Joint Finance Committee passed a new substitute amendment this afternoon that made several changes and deleted a number of the provisions included in the original substitute amendment passed in the Assembly Elections Committee. Could you please redraft the amendments that we have requested to the new sub? In addition, my guess is that a number of the amendments that we had originally requested will now be inapplicable to the new sub. Please feel free to disregard those amendments. Lastly, the new sub amendment deletes all of the MOVE Act requirements. We would like to have a sub similar to the one that we originally requested that contains the MOVE requirements ONLY.
