SENATE AMENDMENT 5, TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 7

May 17, 2011 - Offered by Senators Carpenter and Erpenbach.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute amendment 2, as follows:

- **1.** Page 9, line 3: delete lines 3 to 8 and substitute:
- "(f) An unexpired identification card approved by the board that is issued by a university or college in this state that is accredited, as defined in s. 39.30 (1) (d), or by a technical college created under ch. 38.
- (g) An unexpired identification card issued by a state agency, as defined in s. 20.001 (1), by a local governmental unit, as defined in s. 19.42 (7u), or by the federal government.".
 - **2.** Page 11, line 6: delete lines 6 to 15.
- **3.** Page 11, line 19: delete "10 28" and substitute "10".
- **4.** Page 11, line 23: delete the material beginning with "10 <u>his</u>" and ending with "28" on line 24 and substitute "<u>his or her residence later than</u> 10".

- **5.** Page 12, line 1: delete lines 1 to 13.
- **6.** Page 12, line 17: delete "10 28 consecutive" and substitute "10".
- 7. Page 12, line 21: delete the material beginning with that line and endingwith page 13, line 22.
- **8.** Page 16, line 15: delete "10 28 consecutive" and substitute "10".
- 6 **9.** Page 17, line 21: delete lines 21 to 24.
- 7 **10.** Page 20, line 4: delete "10 28 consecutive" and substitute "10".
- 8 **11.** Page 20, line 25: delete "10 28 consecutive" and substitute "10".
- 9 **12.** Page 24, line 22: delete "10 28 consecutive" and substitute "10".
- 10 **13.** Page 25, line 3: delete lines 3 to 15.

- 11 **14.** Page 32, line 14: delete lines 14 to 23 and substitute:
- **"Section 87m.** 6.85 of the statutes is amended to read:
 - **6.85 Absent elector; definition electors. (1)** An absent elector is any otherwise qualified elector who for any reason is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place in his or her ward <u>or election district</u>.
 - (2) Any otherwise qualified elector who changes residence within this state by moving to a different ward or municipality later than 10 days prior to an election may vote an absentee ballot in the ward or municipality where he or she was qualified to vote before moving.
 - (3) An <u>absent</u> elector qualifying under this section may vote by absentee ballot under ss. 6.86 to 6.89.".
 - **15.** Page 40, line 2: delete "10 later than 28" and substitute "later than 10".

- 1 **16.** Page 52, line 19: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with page 53, line 10.
- 17. Page 60, line 9: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with page 61, line 5.
