**SENATE AMENDMENT 16,
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 7**

May 17, 2011 – Offered by Senators ERPENBACH, VINEHOUT, MILLER, RISSER, S. COGGS,
T. CULLEN and TAYLOR.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
2 amendment 2, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 9, line 14: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 2m.** 5.05 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 5.05 (7) ADMINISTRATIVE MEETINGS AND CONFERENCES. The board shall conduct
6 regular information and training meetings at various locations in the state for
7 county and municipal clerks and other election officials. Administrative meetings
8 shall be designed to explain the election laws and the forms and rules of the board,
9 to promote uniform procedures and to assure that clerks and other officials are made
10 aware of the integrity and importance of the vote of each citizen. In its meetings with
11 clerks and other election officials, the board shall explain the facts that, if an address
12 is shown on the proof of identification submitted by an elector, it need not be the same
13 as the elector’s residence; and if an elector is required to present proof of residence,

1 the elector's current residence must appear on that document. The board may
2 conduct conferences relating to election laws, practice and procedure. The board may
3 charge persons attending the administrative meetings and conferences for its costs
4 incurred in conducting the meetings and conferences at a rate not exceeding the per
5 capita cost incurred by the board.”.

6 **2.** Page 9, line 22: after that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 4m.** 5.35 (6) (a) 4m. of the statutes is created to read:

8 5.35 **(6)** (a) 4m. An explanation of the facts that, if an address is shown on the
9 proof of identification submitted by an elector, it need not be the same as the elector's
10 residence; if an elector is required to present proof of residence, the elector's current
11 residence must appear on that document.”.
