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At the locations indicated, amend ^{*the*} substitute amendment ^{*as*} follows:

1. Page 62, line 24: after that line insert:

“SECTION 108g. 69.22 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

69.22 (1) (intro.) Except as provided in ~~sub.~~ subs. (6) and (7), the state registrar and any local registrar acting under this subchapter shall collect the following fees:

SECTION 108m. 69.22 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

69.22 (7) The state registrar and any local registrar acting under this subchapter may not collect the fees described in sub. (1) if the requester provides the registrar with an affidavit of indigency and a statement, in writing, that the requested vital record is being obtained for the purpose of obtaining an operator’s license issued under ch. 343 or an identification card issued under s. 343.50 for purposes of voting.”.

Please review this amendment to ensure that it is consistent with your intent. Please note that this amendment requires a person to submit an affidavit of indigency. The amendment does not define indigency, and the term is not generally defined in the statutes. Several statutes refer, instead, to the federal poverty line and require a person's gross income to be at or below the poverty line or a certain percent of the poverty line.

See, for example, s. 46.297 (2) (b), which states that a hearing impaired person may be eligible to receive assistance for telecommunication aids if the "adjusted gross income of the person's family is equal to or less than 200% of the poverty line established under 42 USC 9902 (2)." Other statutes use different percents, so if you would like to take that approach to determine what constitutes indigency, we should discuss the exact figures you would like to use.
