



2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 2

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 560.799 (3) (a) and 560.799 (5) (d) (intro.); and *to create*
2 560.799 (3) (d) of the statutes; **relating to:** authorizing the designation of
3 additional enterprise zones and requiring the designation of enterprise zones
4 in rural areas.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 560.799 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
6 560.799 (3) (a) The department may designate not more than ~~12~~ 20 enterprise
7 zones.
8 **SECTION 2.** 560.799 (3) (d) of the statutes is created to read:
9 560.799 (3) (d) Notwithstanding pars. (b) and (c), the department shall
10 designate as enterprise zones at least 3 areas comprising political subdivisions

1 whose populations total less than 5,000 and at least 2 areas comprising political
2 subdivisions whose populations total 5,000 or more but less than 30,000. In
3 designating an enterprise zone under this paragraph, the department may consider
4 indicators of an area's economic need and the effect of designation on other economic
5 development activities.

6 **SECTION 3.** 560.799 (5) (d) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 560.799 (5) (d) (intro.) A business that retains jobs in an enterprise zone, but
8 only if the business makes a significant capital investment in property located in the
9 enterprise zone and, unless the property is located in an enterprise zone designated
10 under sub. (3) (d). at least one of the following applies:
