Department of Veterans Affairs -- Military funeral honors - provide \$68,900 GPR in FY 2011 to fully fund military funeral honors stipend payments to local veterans service organizations.

Income augmentation - Require the Department of Health Services to lapse \$4.5 million FED and the Department of Children and Families to lapse \$2.0112 million PR to the general fund in FY 2011 from Income Augmentation revenues, and require the Secretary of the Department of Administration to apply these lapses to the \$200 million lapse requirement included in 2007 Act 20.
