## SENATE AMENDMENT 3, TO 2011 SENATE BILL 57

May 11, 2011 – Offered by Senators Holperin, Hansen, Wirch, Lassa, Vinehout and Miller.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 2, line 7: after "sentencing" insert "and actions affecting state
3	employees in the office of the district attorney, the Public Defender Board, and the

4 circuit courts".

**"SECTION 99m. Nonstatutory provisions.** 

7 (1) ACTIONS AFFECTING STATE EMPLOYEES IN THE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY,

8 THE PUBLIC DEFENDER BOARD, AND THE CIRCUIT COURTS.

9 (a) In the interest of promoting public safety and convenience and the general 10 welfare, the legislature declares that its intent is to prevent a lack of prosecutorial 11 and defense bar counsel and state-supported court staff for the operation of the 12 criminal justice system. 1 (b) During the 2010–11 fiscal year, the director of the office of state employment 2 relations may not take any action relating to requiring unpaid leaves of absence, 3 imposing permanent or temporary layoffs, or eliminating the positions, or any part 4 thereof, of any state employee in the office of the district attorney, the public defender 5 board, or the circuit courts without the approval of the joint committee on finance. 6 The joint committee on finance may only approve of such actions by a recorded, roll 7 call vote.".
