2011 BILL

1 AN ACT relating to actions affecting state employees in the office of the district
 2 attorney, the Public Defender Board, and the circuit courts.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the director of the Office of State Employment Relations from taking any action during the 2010-11 fiscal year relating to requiring unpaid leaves of absence, imposing permanent or temporary layoffs, or eliminating the positions, or any part thereof, of any state employee in the office of the district attorney, the Public Defender Board, or the circuit courts without the approval of the Joint Committee on Finance (JCF). Under the bill, JCF may only approve of such actions by a recorded, roll call vote.

BILL

1 (a) In the interest of promoting public safety and convenience and the general
2 welfare, the legislature declares that its intent is to prevent a lack of prosecutorial
3 and defense bar counsel and state-supported court staff for the operation of the
4 criminal justice system.

5 (b) During the 2010-11 fiscal year, the director of the office of state employment
6 relations may not take any action relating to requiring unpaid leaves of absence,
7 imposing permanent or temporary layoffs, or eliminating the positions, or any part
8 thereof, of any state employee in the office of the district attorney, the public defender
9 board, or the circuit courts without the approval of the joint committee on finance.
10 The joint committee on finance may only approve of such actions by a recorded, roll
11 call vote. ³⁾ ,
