2011 SENATE BILL 224

1	AN ACT <i>to create</i> 66.0602 (3) (k) of the statutes; relating to: exception to local
2	levy limits for the village of Shorewood.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 66.0602 (3) (k) of the statutes is created to read: 4 66.0602 (3) (k) 1. Subject to subds. 2. and 3., if the village of Shorewood reduces its levy from the amount it would have levied for 2011 if not for an error in the 5 6 valuation of Tax Incremental District Number 1 in the village, to compensate for that 7 error, the limit otherwise applicable under this section to the village in 2012 is 8 increased by the amount of the reduction, as determined by the department of 9 revenue. The amounts added to the village's limit for 2012 under this subdivision 10 may not exceed the amount by which the village underutilized its limit for 2011, as 11 determined by the department of revenue.

1	2. If the village of Shorewood applies funds from the village's general fund in
2	2011 to replace amounts not levied to compensate for an error in the valuation of Tax
