2011 WISCONSIN ACT 88

AN ACT to amend 238.16 (4) (c) of the statutes; relating to: the jobs tax credit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 238.16 (4) (c) of the statutes, as affected by 2011 Wisconsin Act 32, is amended to read: 238.16 (4) (c) Subject to a reallocation by the corpo-

ration pursuant to rules adopted under s. 238.215 238.15 (3) (d), the corporation may allocate up to \$5,000,000 in tax benefits under this section in any calendar year, except that beginning on July 1, 2011, the corporation may allocate up to \$10,000,000 in tax benefits under this section in any calendar year.
