ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 1

October 12, 2011 – Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 238.16 (4) (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** the jobs tax credit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 238.16 (4) (c) of the statutes, as affected by 2011 Wisconsin Act 32,
3 is amended to read:

4 238.16 (4) (c) Subject to a reallocation by the corporation pursuant to rules
5 adopted under s. ~~238.215~~ 238.15 (3) (d), the corporation may allocate up to \$5,000,000
6 in tax benefits under this section in any calendar year, except that beginning on July
7 1, 2011, the corporation may allocate up to \$10,000,000 in tax benefits under this
8 section in any calendar year.
