



2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 63

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 125.32 (3) (b) and 125.68 (4) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 closing hours for certain alcohol beverage retailers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 125.32 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 125.32 **(3)** (b) Class “A” premises may remain open for the conduct of their
5 regular business but may not sell fermented malt beverages between 12 midnight
6 and ~~8~~ 6 a.m. Subsection (2) does not apply to Class “A” premises between 12
7 midnight and ~~8~~ 6 a.m. or at any other time during which the sale of fermented malt
8 beverages is prohibited by a municipal ordinance adopted under par. (d).

9 **SECTION 2.** 125.68 (4) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 125.68 **(4)** (b) “*Class A*” retailers. No premises for which a “Class A” license or
11 permit has been issued may remain open for the sale of intoxicating liquor between

1 the hours of 9 p.m. and ~~8~~ 6 a.m. A municipality may, by ordinance, impose more
2 restrictive hours than those provided in this paragraph.
