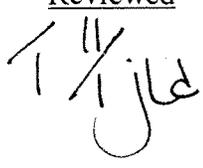

2 **1.** Page 2, line 8: after "code;" insert "establishing the salary of the governor;" ✓

3 **2.** Page 5, line 1: before that line insert: ✓

4 **"SECTION 1h.** 20.923 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read: ✓

5 20.923 (2) (c) The annual salary of the governor shall be set at 21.6% above the
6 minimum of the salary range for executive salary group 10 300 percent of the mean
7 annual salary for all occupations in Wisconsin, as determined by the bureau of labor
8 statistics in the federal department of labor." ✓
