We have another rush draft for you - hopefully this one will do the trick. We would like to redraft this old draft from 2009-10 (attached) as a completely new LRB number, with one modification:

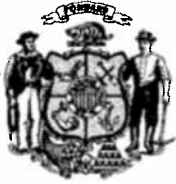
-All of paragraph 4 (lines 13 through 20) should be replaced with:

1 AN ACT to create 349.217 of the statutes; relating to: authorizing local  
2 governments to appoint traffic control attendants to direct or regulate traffic  
3 for special events.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes any municipality or county to adopt an ordinance under which traffic control attendants may be appointed to direct or regulate traffic at special events in the municipality or county. Any appointment of a traffic control attendant must specify all dates and times, and locations, for which the appointment is valid. No municipality or county may appoint a person as a traffic control attendant unless the person has received prior training in traffic control and traffic safety. A person appointed as a traffic control attendant has the same authority as a traffic officer to direct or regulate traffic and is considered a traffic officer for purposes of certain violations. While exercising the privileges of a traffic control attendant, a person appointed as a traffic control attendant must wear an insignia or uniform that designates the person as a traffic control attendant and must be equipped with signals or signs to direct or regulate traffic at the event.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. 349.217 of the statutes is created to read:

2 **349.217 Authority to appoint traffic control attendants.** ✓ (1) The  
3 governing body of any municipality or county may by ordinance provide for the  
4 appointment of traffic control attendants for the protection of persons who are  
5 crossing a highway at or near a location where a special event is being held in the  
6 municipality or county.

7 (2) If a person is appointed as a traffic control attendant under ✓ sub. (1), the  
8 appointment shall specify all dates and times, and locations, for which the  
9 appointment is valid.

10 (3) No municipality or county may appoint a person as a traffic control  
11 attendant under sub. ✓ (1) unless the person has received prior training in traffic  
12 control and traffic safety.

13 (4) A person appointed as a traffic control attendant shall have the same  
14 authority as a traffic officer to direct or regulate traffic, and shall be considered a  
15 traffic officer for purposes of violations of ss. 346.04 and 346.175, during the dates  
16 and times, and at the locations, specified in the appointment as provided in sub. (2).  
17 While exercising the privileges under this subsection, a traffic control attendant  
18 shall wear an insignia or uniform that designates the person as a traffic control  
19 attendant and shall be equipped with all signals or signs necessary to direct or  
20 regulate traffic.
