## 2011 WISCONSIN ACT 153

AN ACT *to create* 30.12 (1n) of the statutes; **relating to:** a permit exemption for the placement of a pier containing a floating toilet facility in the St. Croix National Scenic Riverway.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 30.12 (1n) of the statutes is created to read:

30.12 (**1n**) FLOATING TOILET FACILITIES. (a) In this subsection, "national park service" means the national park service, federal department of the interior.

(b) The placement of a pier that meets all of the fol-

lowing requirements is exempt from the permit requirements under this section:

- 1. The pier contains a floating toilet facility that meets technical specifications approved by the national park service for floating toilet facilities.
- 2. The pier is owned and placed by the national park service along a federally owned shoreline in a federally administered area of the St. Croix National Scenic Riverway.
