

JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This draft was prepared for the Joint Legislative Council's Special Committee on Review of Higher Education Financial Aids Programs.

This draft creates a temporary commission on financial aid consolidation and modernization in the higher education aids board (HEAB). The draft specifies the membership of the commission to consist of the following 11 members:

- The HEAB executive secretary.
- The chairperson of HEAB.
- A HEAB member designated by the chairperson.
- Two representatives of the University of Wisconsin System.
- Two representatives of the Wisconsin technical college system.
- Two representatives of the Wisconsin association of independent colleges and universities.
- One member of the Assembly appointed by the speaker of the Assembly.
- One member of the Senate appointed by the Senate majority leader.

The commission is directed to study the potential for consolidating all grant programs administered by HEAB into a single, comprehensive, need-based grant program, as well as options for providing grant aid for students who are attending Wisconsin institutions of higher education at less than full-time credit loads. The commission is directed to report its recommendations to HEAB and the legislature no later than April 1, 2012, at which time the commission shall terminate its activities and cease to exist.

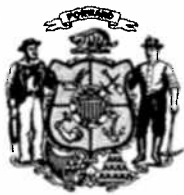
