Sen. Grothman:

This bill refers to an individual's noncommercial use of an ozone-depleting refrigerant substitute (ODR substitute) that is sold in a container of less than 15 pounds. The term "noncommercial use" is intended to distinguish between an individual who uses an ODR substitute on his or her own motor vehicle (which constitutes a noncommercial use) and an individual who uses an ODR substitute in the course of his or her employment by an installation, service, or repair business (which constitutes a commercial use). Is that okay?
