1 **AN ACT ...; relating to: eliminating ambulatory surgical center assessment.**

*DOR* **Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau** *(DOR)*

Under current law, the Department of Revenue may impose an assessment on ambulatory surgical centers. The Department of Health Services allocates any assessment among the ambulatory surgical centers in proportion to their gross patient revenue. The Department of Revenue, if it imposes an assessment, must transfer 99.5 percent of the moneys collected to the Medical Assistance trust fund, which pays some of the costs for the Medical Assistance program. This bill eliminates on July 1, 2013, the ability for the Department of Revenue to impose this assessment on ambulatory surgical centers. *DOR*

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**

- 2 **SECTION 1.** 20.566 (1) (gn) of the statutes is repealed. *x*
- 3 **SECTION 2.** 25.77 (13) of the statutes is repealed. *x*
- 4 **SECTION 3.** 146.98 of the statutes is repealed. *x*
- 5 **SECTION 4. Effective date.**
