**SENATE AMENDMENT 7,
TO 2011 SENATE BILL 237**

October 27, 2011 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 6, line 21: delete that line and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 16m.** 118.019 (2) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 118.019 (2d) and
4 amended to read:

5 118.019 (2d) NONDISCRIMINATION. Use An instructional program under this
6 section shall use instructional methods and materials that, consistent with s. 118.13
7 (1), do not promote bias discriminate against pupils of any a pupil based upon the
8 pupil’s race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or ethnic or cultural background or
9 against sexually active pupils or children with disabilities. Nothing in this
10 subsection shall be construed to prohibit a school board from approving an
11 instructional program under this section that includes instruction on abstinence
12 from sexual activity or that is abstinence-centered.”.
