4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 946.70 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:		
	946.70 (title) Impersonating peace officers, fire fighters, or other		
	emergency personnel.		
	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 946.70 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 946.70 (1) (a).		
	SECTION 3. 946.70 (1) (b), (c) and (d) of the statutes are created to read:		
	946.70 (1) (b) Except as provided in sub. (2), whoever impersonates a fire		
	fighter with intent to mislead others into believing that the person is actually a fire		
	fighter is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
